Dave's latest PSA test showed a ZERO! The doctor would like to see him again in January, and then have a six-month follow-up. Meanwhile, Dave has nearly completed the specialized therapy; and although he has not been able to recuperate 100 percent, he has made significant progress. Our prayer is that he might heal completely in the months to come.

With all of this in mind, the doctor has told Dave that he is clear to return to Chile whenever he feels that he can handle it. So, we have set the date to go back to the field on January 10, 2017. As you can imagine, we are extremely excited, and a little nervous! As soon as our Chilean Pastors heard about our plans, they began to ask us to participate in services, meetings and camps. It won't take long for us to get involved!

Please pray for us as we endeavor to take up the reins once again. We understand that we have a few limitations on our physical strength and ability right now, but we also know that the Lord always leads each one to serve within their means, and we trust Him for each day as it comes.
