We have had several folks ask about our RV--unfortunately it is still here and not sold. God knows the correct timing and reason why so we just must trust HIM. We will be heading to Apache Creek Deaf camp July 9-15th with 16 total—please be in prayer that those who are lost will be saved. We had 3 saved there last year and hope for the same, or more! Pray the Lord will open up some new doors to reach the Deaf in our area as well as the hearing. We are not a respecter of persons! Continue to pray for a family to help us in some areas of the church, thank God for a family that has been helping with the driving!
