Another two months of serving Jesus have flown by! It's great to know as we onward go, we are laying up eternal treasures, if we let the temporal go by, that is. I can truly say it is a blessing to be here in Colorado Springs, in God's will, with my family, and able to be in the ministry of reconciliation. Let me add it would be much more difficult without the prayers, support, and encouragement from people like yourselves. Thank you so much from my family, Solid Rock Deaf Baptist Church, and myself.

What has been happening here in the Springs? A lot of visiting, handing out John & Romans, praying, and outreach. We have been super busy with the Character classes in the Deaf and Blind school. Which has been provoking some Bible questions--the last one was Proverbs 14:12, keep praying. I am hoping and praying to see some of these young people saved. We have had visitors coming every so often, repeat visitors, and folks asking about the church, Amen. We have been studying the life of Paul & why his ministry was so powerful, and have been doing spiritual warfare in Sunday School. These have been a blessing to me and seem to be a help to the folks we have coming. Speaking of that, we had a total of 30 with 9 of them Deaf folks one Sunday, and a total of 39 on Resurrection Sunday, 11 being Deaf!! Thank you Lord!

One area that has been a blessing, especially to my boys, is our youth activities we hold monthly at the church (and are able to attend monthly at different local churches). We had our activity in April; we were expecting around 30 and we had 65. These were comprised of several churches in the area and we even had 2 new kids from our church! We are really praying about discernment on reaching the kids in our area, please be in prayer with us. We have had a few young Deaf folks visit, just keep praying they will come back and be faithful. Also be praying for our "teen revival" we will be holding May 13th. It will be a challenge to the kids to "walk" with the Lord during the summer months and we will have 3 preachers.

I was honored and blessed to be asked to preach at the Deaf Baptist Fellowship of America (Western States) during the last week of April. I sure pray lives have been challenged and changed for HIS glory. It continues to break my heart when I think of the thousands of Deaf right here in our own country not getting the gospel and BIBLE preaching. Let's continue praying for laborers--that might be YOU!!

I would also ask that you continue to pray our RV sells before the end of the summer, that those who have been saved would submit for baptism, and that folks would join. It seems as if we are in a time that commitment is not so important. Also please pray for Isaiah and his graduation May 24th, God's direction in his life establishing Deaf ministries, & a college to attend. In addition,

pray for Benjamin's 10-week missions trip to Australia and New Zealand this summer, for safety, and for the Lord moving in his heart. As always folks it is a tremendous blessing and privilege to be your missionaries to reach the Deaf world, specifically here in Colorado Springs.
