Hello from Ecuador! My prayer is that this letter finds you keeping the faith. With many turning their backs on God and His work, it is a blessing to know that there are some that still love Him and are actively serving Him.

The work here in El Quinche has been slow but steady. We have seen several families leave over Scriptural baptism and because of the influence of worldly things, but we are seeing a couple of people come back which shows that a love and a need for the Word of God in their lives can help them be blessed of God. We continue to have good attendance for our Thursday night Bible study. We have been learning to share a Gospel presentation, a presentation to win backslidden Christians, and a presentation on how to follow-up to help people grow spiritually. I am planning to make a big evangelistic push here in El Quiche with new tracts and literature that I will be printing. I remain optimistic that we can reach more people here in El Quiche.

We are currently making a big evangelistic push in the mountains behind El Quinche. Brother Eric Moore and I have been going up into the mountains on our new motorcycles with the purpose of getting a Bible in every home and sharing the Gospel when possible. We have made two trips up, and I have shared the Gospel with at least eight people. We have passed out over twenty-five Bibles with invitations to our Sunday Bible study at noon. We have seen some fruit already and are excited to continue this work in spite of very difficult road conditions in these mountains. We have already had a few spills, but everything is well. I need to purchase some more gear for better protection. I want to give special thanks to Victory Baptist Temple, Covington, Kentucky, and Badger Road Baptist Church, Fairbanks, Alaska, for helping me to purchase the motorcycle; and Lighthouse Indian Baptist Church, Pearland, Texas, for the purchase of a helmet and gloves; and my home church Mission Blvd. Baptist Church for their constant support.

As always we appreciate your prayers and support! I would ask that you pray for our visa permission that is coming up for renewal in December. Please pray that all the paperwork and documents necessary can be received from the government agencies in the U.S. so that we can get them turned in by December 15th.
