


We are praying for the Sexton family, Temple Baptist Church and the Crown College. We rest in the hope that Christ gives and the promise of eternal life with the Lord.



Zimbabwe







In the month of September, we held a special service to highlight the ministry in Zimbabwe and to encourage people to pray for the Lord's guidance in beginning a work there. We had a wonderful evening eating sadza and relish, looking at photos from previous mission trips, speaking to the Recean family who are stationed there and hearing a challenge from God's Word. That night, Levi Mullins drove down from Birmingham with the pastor of his sending church who also supports our family. Following the service, this pastor asked if we would like to return to Zimbabwe and informed us that if we did, he would like to help our family purchase tickets. Of course

we were shocked. It's not every day that someone offers to pay for nine plane tickets, especially for such a long journey!

Later, the same pastor contacted us again, letting us know that he meant what he said and that his church would like to help us get to Zimbabwe if we felt that was what the Lord wanted. We had been praying about whether or not Derrick should go on the trip that was scheduled for December, but now began to pray about the whole family going. We decided to take a few days as a family to pray and seek the Lord specifically about this, and at the end of the week, the pastor contacted us again. We believe that the Lord opened this door for our family for this time. We are grateful for the Buffalo Ridge Baptist Church and Pastor Herdman for giving our family this opportunity. We are trusting the Lord to use us and guide us during this time and are anticipating great things that the Lord will do in Zimbabwe.

Our Pastor, before his passing, spoke of praying for four miracle years, and we believe that this open door in Zimbabwe is just one of the many ways that that Lord will answer his prayer, God willing. We are thankful that we were able to speak to Pastor on multiple occasions about Zimbabwe, relating the miraculous way in which the property was given, showing him pictures and videos of our previous trip there and thinking about what great things God could do. In July, I had the privilege of preaching at Temple Baptist Church's National Youth

Congress. It was precious to spend time with Pastor and Mrs. Sexton. During one of our times together, Pastor Johnny Pope was with us and Pastor Sexton said to me, "Derrick, tell Johnny what God is doing in Zimbabwe!" It was a joy to share what God is doing and what we are trusting Him to do in the days that are ahead.

"And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it..." Isaiah 30:21

We don't have all the answers as to how things should proceed, but we believe this is an open door from the Lord and that we must walk through it. Lord willing, we will spend a few months in Zimbabwe, both to help the work move forward, as well as to take some much needed time for our family. For many years, Seth Izer, a Crown graduate, has been my Assistant Pastor here in Oxford. During our time away, Seth will lead the church and we trust that the Lord will enable him for this task. The Lord has also blessed our church with many faithful, "second-mile" people who will stand beside Seth and help him in our absence.
