Three weeks ago, at the writing of the last letter, I mentioned a “door” that we would explore. There is a Baptist Church in the capital city that is considering sponsoring me into the country, “with no strings attached.” They are considering the writing of the letter that would satisfy the requirement of the Immigration Office.

On that Friday (12th), I approached the pastor of the church, and he took my request before the deacons. They wanted to see some documentation and a letter from our home church, which we have given them. This past Sunday, January 28th, the pastor and deacons were supposed to have met to discuss, and hopefully decide if they will sponsor me. Since Monday, I have been trying to contact that pastor, and he is not responding.

If they decide to sponsor me, they will furnish the last piece of paper needed for our TRPs (visas) to be completed. If they do not, I have one more person in “office” to visit. Tomorrow, (Thursday, Feb. 1st), I am planning to go to the capital and see if the Lord will connect me to the right people who can help me with this situation. As of right now, we will have to leave the country on February 17th.

Thank you for your prayers! Many of you have communicated with me about this and we are very thankful for all of you praying.

ANSWERED PRAYER

Last Thursday, February 1st, I went to the capitol to meet with a man in high office. We met in NYC back in September. At that time, I had a good witness with him, and he asked me to visit him when I arrived in Swaziland. So, when I showed up at his office, he was very happy to see me, and he remembered our entire conversation in September.

While in his office, I explained to him of my situation. He made a phone call and got me an appointment with the Minister of Home Affairs. This meeting connected me with the Chief Immigration Officer, who told me the course of action that I needed to take (which had never been told to me by anyone until this point). On Monday, we went back to Home Affairs to pursue this pathway, and the doors are opening for us to get our visas.

The short of this pathway is this: Our home church needs to officially start a church in Swaziland which will then sponsor me into the country. The church can be started as a “Stand Alone” church (we would call it an independent church) and it doesn’t have to be part of the Conference of Churches. Then, if the new church writes a letter to explain why they are not part of the Conference, the church can sponsor a missionary into the country!

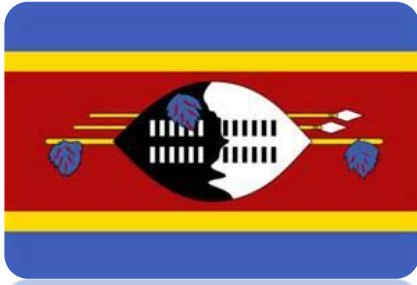
