After a busy end of the year, the beginning of the year has been a little slower but we praise the Lord for the work He is still doing through the ministry in White Earth.

Discipleship

Over the last few years, we have learned that discipleship is more than just Bible studies. It is a regular investment into the lives of people. It is coming alongside them with the Word of God to show them to where Jesus wants them to be. We are praying to be more effective in our discipleship but we praise the Lord for small steps of victories. A couple of ladies who faithfully and exclusively attended the Thursday night services took a step of faith and began to attend the Sunday services as well! Tyler, who was recently saved and baptized, has been a real encouragement to us in her growth. She has expressed her continued desire to see her family come to know the truth of Jesus Christ like she has. Please pray for Tyler because it seems the more she gives the gospel and the more she grows, the more intense the enemy battles. Pray she will have victory in the battle and boldness from the Lord to win her family to Jesus!

Over the last month, I have been preaching and teaching on what is a church and what is discipleship. One of the aspects of ministry we are most burdened about is getting people to learn the Bible for themselves outside of church services. This past Thursday, we started what we are calling Disciple Fellowships. This is a time where we are teaching them how to hear from God in His Word, how to take steps of obedience from what they learned, and how to share what they learned with others. This is an opportunity that we have to train the Ojibwe to be disciple-makers among their own people. My prayer is that one day we can take one of these Disciple Fellowships and send them into another town on the reservation to plant another church.

Kids Ministry

As I continue to preach and visit with the adults at Hope Baptist, I have increasingly become more burdened for the kids on the reservation as well as our own family. Lord-willing in March, we are starting a Hope 4 Kids service every other Monday night. We are inviting families to come. Pray for us as we prepare to start this outreach!

GoMission Conference

We are excited to have our first missions conference at Hope Baptist Church March 28-31. We will have Bro. Dheidrick Hobbs and his wife, Joetta, with us. They are a Navajo couple on deputation to plant a church on the Navajo Reservation. We are excited to have this couple come to present their mission field and challenge the Ojibwe people to reach their own tribe as well. We are praying that with the celebration of Resurrection Sunday the same weekend, this will be a great opportunity of preaching the gospel and training others to go. Pray that we will see people get excited about giving the gospel and that souls would be saved during our GoMission Conference.

On February 13, Aliza turned 6 years old! We are very thankful for the 6 years the Lord has given us with her. Thank you to those who sent birthday cards to Aliza as she enjoyed opening each one.
